ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

The qualification slot is allocated to the individual athlete, not to the NPC. In the case of a Bipartite Commission Invitation the qualification slot is also allocated to the individual athlete not to the NPC.

MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC

An NPC can be allocated a maximum of eight (8) male qualification slots and a maximum of eight (8) female qualification slots for a total of sixteen (16) qualification slots with a maximum of one (1) slot allowed per medal event.

Exceptions may be granted through the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for competition athletes must:

- be born before 1 January 2011;

- have competed in at least one (1) international, sanctioned IBSA competition which provides World Ranking Points between 1 September 2022 and 24 June 2024; and
- be internationally classified in an eligible Sport Class with a Sport Class Status of (i) Confirmed; or (ii) Review with a Fixed Review Date of 2025 or later.

MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of one (1) eligible athlete per individual event with exceptions granted to Bipartite invitees. NPCs may only enter an athlete in the medal event in which the athlete has obtained a qualification slot.

QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

Qualification slots will be allocated in the following order:

Host Country Allocation	The host country directly qualifies one (1) athlete in each medal event for which the host country has entered at least one (1) athlete in the 2022 IBSA Judo World Championships. Host country slots will be allocated to the highest-ranked athlete from the host country (not otherwise qualified) on the IBSA Judo World Ranking List closing 24 June 2024. Any unused host country slots will be allocated via the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method.	8 male athletes 8 female athletes
Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation	Thirty (30) athletes will be selected by IBSA and the IPC for Bipartite Commission Invitation slots. To be considered for a Bipartite slot, NPCs must submit an official application in writing to IBSA by 8 July 2024.	30 athletes

TIMELINE

1 September 2022	Start of the period for performances, at dedicated IBSA events, to be recorded on the IBSA Judo World Ranking List
tbd	Deadline for Paris 2024 Organising Committee to receive accreditation application forms submitted by NPCs ("Accreditation Long List")
24 June 2024	End of the period for performances to be recorded on the IBSA Judo World Ranking List
24 June 2024	Start of Bipartite Commission Invitation application process
1 July 2024	IBSA confirms in writing to the NPCs the allocation of qualification and host country slots

8 July 2024	NPCs confirm in writing to IBSA the use of allocated qualification and host country slots
8 July 2024	Deadline to submit Bipartite Commission Invitation applications to IBSA
15 July 2024	IBSA confirms in writing to the NPCs the reallocation of unused qualification slots
15 July 2024	IBSA confirms in writing the awarding of Bipartite Commission Invitation slots
5 August 2024	Deadline for Paris 2024 Organising Committee to receive sport entry forms submitted by NPCs

CONFIRMATION PROCESS OF ALLOCATED SLOTS

By 8 July 2024 each qualified NPC must confirm to IBSA in writing (only email is accepted) if they wish to use their allocated slots. NPCs that have not responded by this date will lose their team qualification slots, and IBSA may reallocate these slots.

By 15 July 2024 IBSA will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused qualification slots.

By 15 July 2024 it is officially declared that the respective NPCs will use the allocated slots for the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use its allocated slots may be subject to sanctions by IPC and IBSA.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Any qualification slots allocated and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated to the highest ranked athlete in the same medal event (whose NPC is not otherwise qualified) on the IBSA Judo World Ranking List closing 24 June 2024.
