C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

C.1. Compliance with the Olympic Charter and other relevant rules

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of

Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the EOC and the rules of Beach Soccer Worldwide, may participate in the 2023 European Games.

C.2. Age requirements

According to BSWW regulations and FIFA laws of the game, no age limitation is to be applied.

C.3. Additional Beach Soccer Worldwide criteria

All athletes shall present a valid and original passport upon arrival at the first official training session.

D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

The qualification system allows for the participation of the best athletes through a fair and transparent process within the framework of the Olympic Charter.

E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

The EOC will inform by email the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places by September 15, 2022.

By September 30, 2022, eligible NOCs must inform, by email, the EOC whether or not they intend to use the allocated quota places and participate at the 2023 European Games.

F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

Any unused quota place (including qualification places and host NOC places) will be allocated to the next best ranked NOC in qualification tournament in the respective event. This process will be repeated until all places are allocated.
