C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

C.1. Compliance with the Olympic Charter and other relevant rules

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of

Competitions, including the rules and conditions of participation established by the EOC and UEC, may participate in the 2023 European Games.

C.2. Age requirements

To be eligible to participate in the 2023 European Games, athletes must be aged 15 years old and over (born on 2008 or before)

C.3. Additional UEC requirements

Athletes must also comply with the following criteria:

 Athletes must hold a UCI license, from a National Federation, UEC member, valid for 2023

D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

The qualification system allows the participation of the best athletes through a fair and transparent process within the framework of the Olympic Charter.

D.1. Qualification process

- Every NOC can register two athletes in each event before the first registration deadline. This means each NOC can register a maximum of 2 Men Elite and 2 Women Elite riders.
- If quota places are still available, the highest ranked nations will have an opportunity to take an extra available quota place in each event. Starting with the highest ranked nation in the BMX Freestyle Park Elite Ranking from April 19, 2023 (in the respective gender), a nation has the chance to take another quota place until the total of 31 quota places per event is reached. Each NOC has a maximum of 3 quota places per event.

E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

On 24 April 2023, EOC in agreement with UEC sends the quota place confirmation forms to the NOCs.

By 15 May 2023, NOCs confirm the number of quota places they will use to the EOC

F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

All available unused quota places, will be reallocated to the highest ranked nations in the BMX Freestyle Park Elite Ranking from April 19, 2023 (in the respective gender), respecting the maximum number of athletes per NOC per event.

G. QUALIFICATION TIMELINE

24 April 2023	EOC in agreement with UEC sends the quota place confirmation forms to the NOCs
15 May 2023	NOCs confirm the number of quota places they will use to the EOC
16 May 2023	The EOC, in agreement with the UEC starts the process of reallocating available quota places
2 June 2023	European Games 2023 Sport Entries Deadline
21 June - 2 July 2023	European Games 2023
