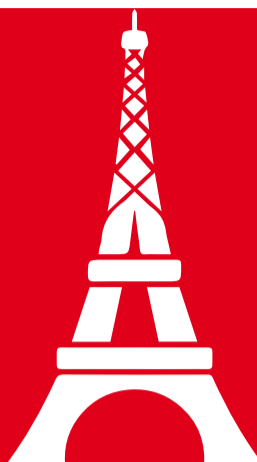


District Spot Paris

In 2024, the project will continue with the addition of new sports workshops (basketball, badminton, dance, climbing), the Europeanization of the project with a meeting in Brussels with the Sport2Be association, and the organization of holiday "internships" combining discussion workshops, sports, and professional meetings. The year will also be marked by the Olympic and Paralympic Games, during which the role models will organize their Sociolympic neighborhood games.
